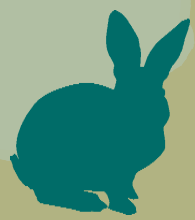


CHINA

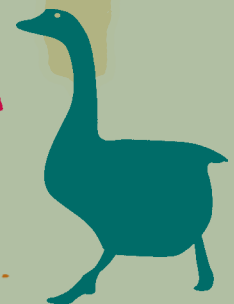
